

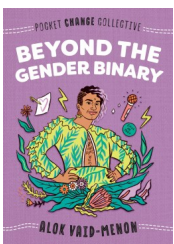
Gender Queer

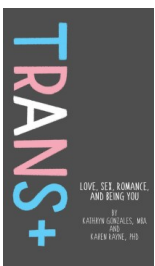
Boys Run the Riot. 1

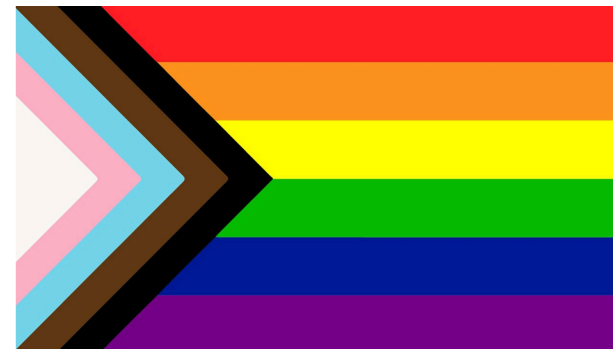

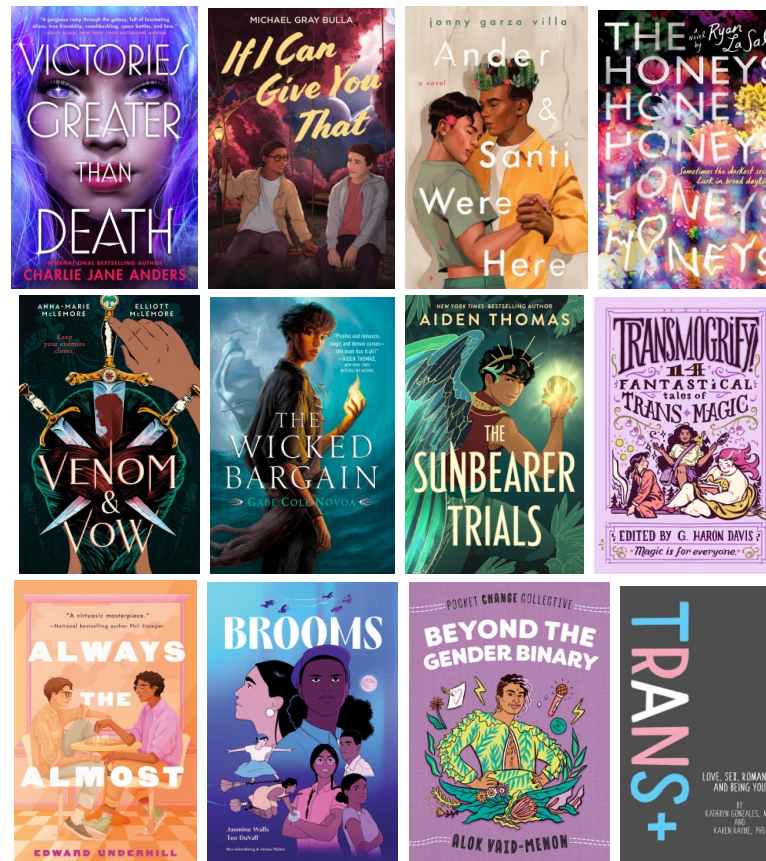

by Charlie Jane Anders (she/her) - Y ANDERS

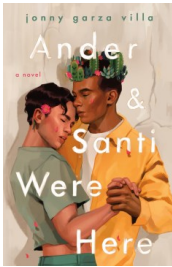
A brilliant alien commander's human clone teams up with her best friend and crewmates to protect a world that does not yet know that alien life exists.

by Michael Gray Bulla (he/him) - Y BULLA

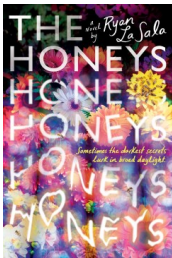
Seventeen-year-old Gael, a trans boy, learns to let his walls down while finding community, discovering his sexuality, falling in love, and navigating difficult family situations

by Aiden Thomas (he/they) - Y THOMAS

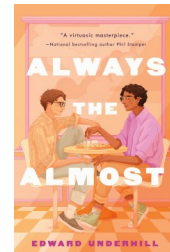
