

Request to Reconsider Digital Access to Special Collections Materials Form

Anyone concerned that material in the Library's digital special collections violates their rights under copyright law is encouraged to complete this form.

Anyone with concerns regarding sensitive information (e.g., Social Security numbers, personal health information, FERPA protected educational records, etc.) or culturally sensitive materials (e.g., information protected by Native American communities) represented in the Library's digital special collections is encouraged to complete this form.

This form must be completed in full for each digital special collections item. Receipt of a completed form facilitates an in-depth review of the material by library staff. A written response will be provided within 30 days and will include an option for an administrative appeal to the Library Director, and thereafter, to the Library Commission. Until a determination is made, the item will remain in the Library's digital special collections.
