


TALK</b> Show your child the flag of the country where you were born. Name all the colors.</p>	<p><b>15. READ</b> Put on hats and read a book together outside in the sunshine.</p>	<p><b>16. PLAY</b> Pretend to be your favorite animal. What will you do? What do you eat?</p>	<p><b>17. MATH</b> Use fruits and vegetables to talk about round and oval shapes.</p>	<p><b>18. WRITE</b> Draw a picture of yourself, and give it to your dad or grandpa.</p>
<p><b>19. TALK</b> Tell your dad or grandpa what you love most about him. </p>	<p><b>20. READ</b> Read a book together and act out what the characters do.</p>	<p><b>21. PLAY</b> Today is the first day of summer. Put on some music and dance in celebration!</p>	<p><b>22. SING</b> Sing: “<b>Zoom, zoom, zoom.</b>”</p>	<p><b>23. SCIENCE</b> Talk about the sun and how plants need it to grow.</p>	<p><b>24. LIBRARY</b> Find a kids event at any library and attend for free!</p>	<p><b>25.
