

# WHAT IS A STUDENT ONECARD



**Student OneCard** is a digital library account that allows you to access library books and online tools.

Students are able to use their Student ID Numbers as **Sonoma County Library** account numbers.

# SIGNING-IN



You will need to know your:

- School District prefix
- Your Student ID
- Your 4-Digit Pin

**Pin Example:**



