

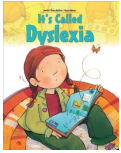


Marcus Vega No Habla Español

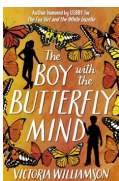


Tally, la Niña Tigre

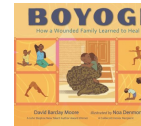


Meneos, Pisotones, y Apretones para Calmar mi Cosquilleo
