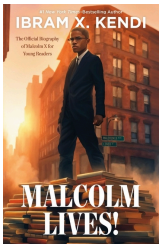

When her parents announce they are divorcing, Huda Fahmy struggles to keep her plans on track for junior year.



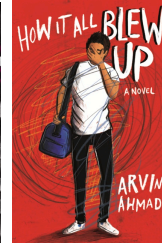
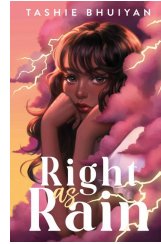
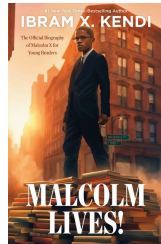
