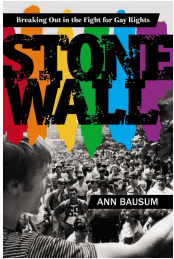

A dramatic retelling of the Stonewall riots of 1969, introducing teen readers to the decades-long struggle for gay rights.



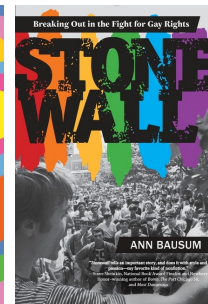
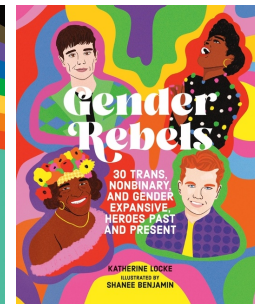
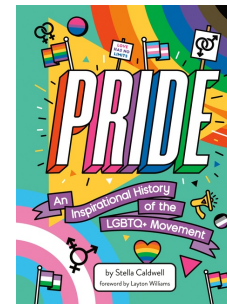
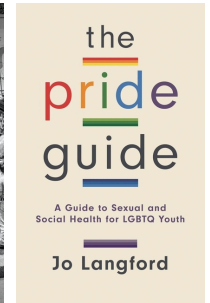
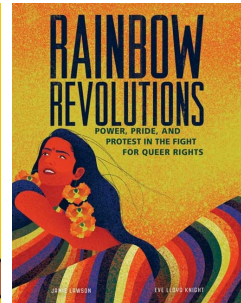
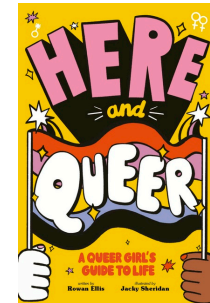
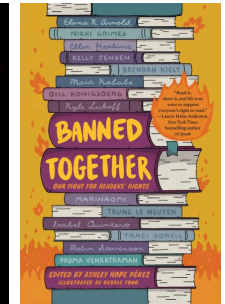
### Flamboyants: The Queer Harlem Renaissance I Wish I'd Known

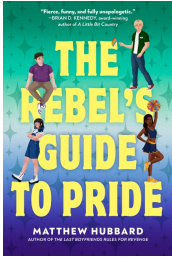


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## The Rebel's Guide to Pride
